Teachers voted the audio read-aloud feature as their favorite support tool.

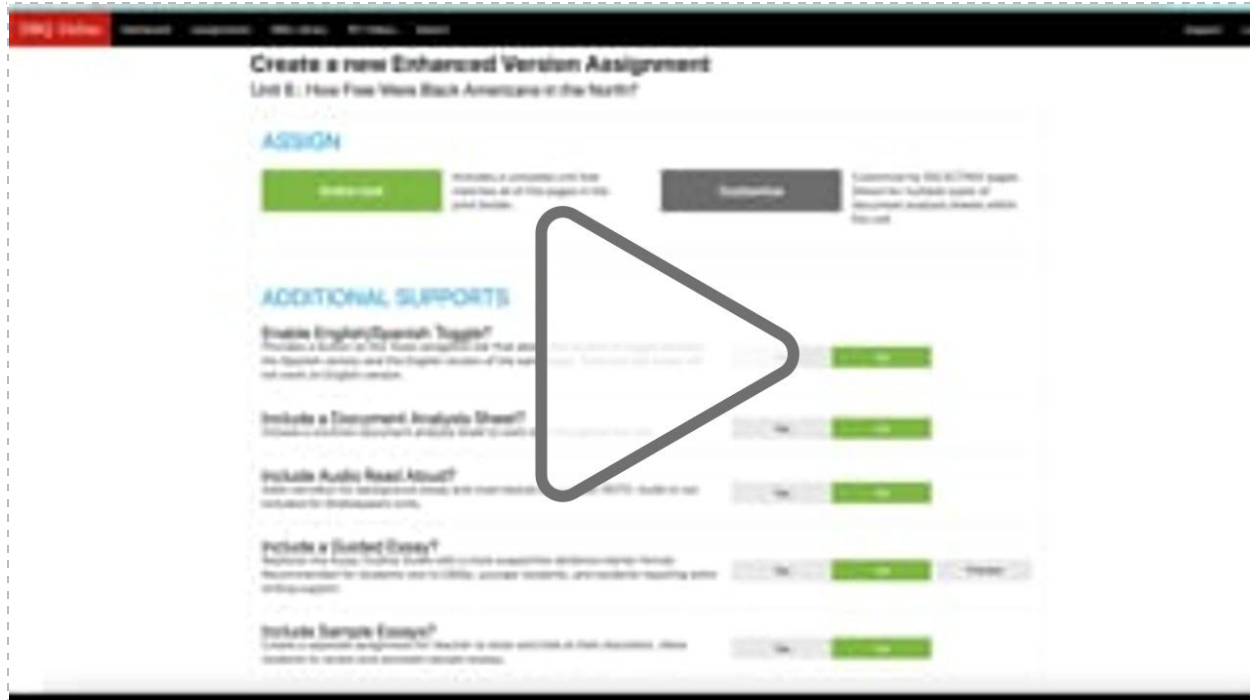

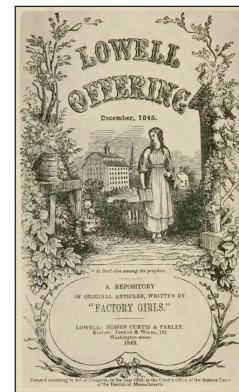

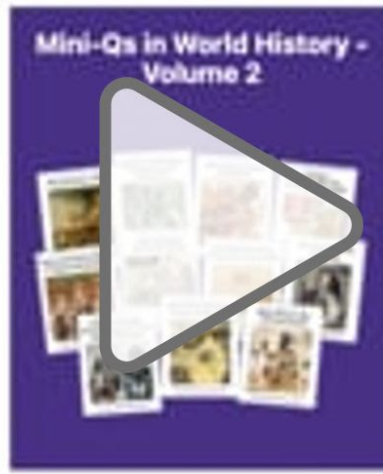
