For greater engagement and deeper conceptual understanding
For 5-12 Science Educators

Course Description:

Join us for a series of three hands-on in-person days that focus on evidence-based teaching & learning strategies that you can use tomorrow. In these workshops we will learn how to construct learning sequences that are engaging to students, produce durable conceptual change that helps students make sense of the world around them, using cross-cutting concepts and science & engineering practices in a systematic way that builds on what they already know. The goal is to stimulate lifelong curiosity and problem-solving ability in a way that the brain naturally does it. Expect to work alone and have time to bounce your ideas off your colleagues as you find your own path through what you teach in your class.

& *October 4 only required for university credit*

A Natural History Immersion Experience in Colorado's San Luis Valley
For PreK-12 Educators, Friends & Family Members over 12 years of age

Course Description:

Join us for a 3-day, 2-night immersion experience in southern Colorado, camping and exploring at the foot of the towering Sangre De Cristo Mountain range. Explore the largest sand dunes in North America. Learn about the geology, hydrology and natural history of this unique area-Great Sand Dunes National Park. Visit a waterfall and hike into the surrounding mountains. Engage in Citizen Science. Learn about montane ecosystems. By night enjoy the night skies of an International Dark Sky Park, one of the darkest places in the country.
